## Memorandum of Understanding HUB-IN Alliance Early Joiners 2023-24

## Introduction

HUB-IN is a European project funded by HOFiZon 2020 exploring how to harness innovation and entrepreneurship to regenerate Historic Urban Areas, while preserving their unique cultural and social identity and the environment.

To grow the legacy of HUB-IN, the aim is to develop an Alliance of like-minded cities.

Developing the Alliance will take place through two stages.

Stage one is to bring together an informal group of early joiners. The role of an early joiner is to engage, follow and contribute to developing the final Alliance.

Stage two will be the development of the final Alliance, a formal network.




